Dear Lenten Mentor,

Lenten Mentoring is a special part of our Confirmation Ministry; providing students with the opportunity to learn and grow in their faith through conversations and activities with an adult mentor from the congregation. Together mentors and mentees will share and learn from one another about what it means to live as a Christian in the world today. Thank you for agreeing to be a Lenten Mentor!

Every week students (mentees) and mentors will meet at 5:50 pm in the Fellowship Hall for an introduction to the topic for the evening, after the introduction pairs will be free to go talk more about the topic in a location of their choosing until 7:00 pm. This year's dates for Lenten Mentoring are –

- February 14 (Ash Wednesday)- our kickoff
- February 21
- February 28
- March 7
- March 14
- March 21

We ask mentors to attend one of our two identical orientation sessions on Sunday, February 11 at 11:00 am or 12 o'clock noon in the Youth Room. You will learn more about the theme for this year and ask any questions you have about mentoring. The curriculum this year will be based on questions confirmation students have asked as they have reflected on lessons and sermons from worship this fall. Our theme this year is *Where Faith Meets Life: Your questions about Faith and Life*. It is always helpful to have all the mentors together to hear any new information we have and learn from each other.

You and your mentee should complete the Mentor/Mentee Contact Information form and divided it up as indicated. It is very important the bottom section of the form is turned into the church office on or before Sunday, February 4, so we know the pairing has been secured. If you are meeting your mentee for the first time on February 14 at our first session please arrive by 5:40 pm so we can introduce you to your student.
