Augustana COVID Task Force

We continue to closely monitor the daily COVID statistics for our local area and will make monthly recommendations. For October our recommendations are:

- Wear a mask indoors and practice social distancing for large group gatherings regardless of vaccination status. We ask that children, youth, and volunteers wear a mask indoors as we know kids under 12 cannot be vaccinated.
- Do not enter the building if you have any cold or flu-like symptoms or if you know you have recently been exposed to someone with COVID.
- Choose the worship experience that best meets your comfort level. Drive-In Worship will be offered through October at 8:30 am. The pre-recorded online service will be available every Sunday. In addition, a traditional sanctuary worship will be offered at 9:45 am along with a contemporary worship in the Fellowship Hall at 11:00 am.
- Move outdoors to visit between Sunday services. The COVID Task Force will continue to monitor local COVID statistics and CDC and MDH guidelines. We will update our recommendations as needed. Thank you for your cooperation.
